From the time you declared the 2009 planning committee dissolved. I have no responsibility what so ever to you or to your organization.

I spent a large contribution of my time for the convention. I have other responsibilities that I need to take care of. You see this convention as just another means of profit, and I wish you a success, however I'm different from you.

You have NO RIGHT to command me "**Gởi ngay bảng danh sách**" or ask me to spend any more of my time to you or your organization.

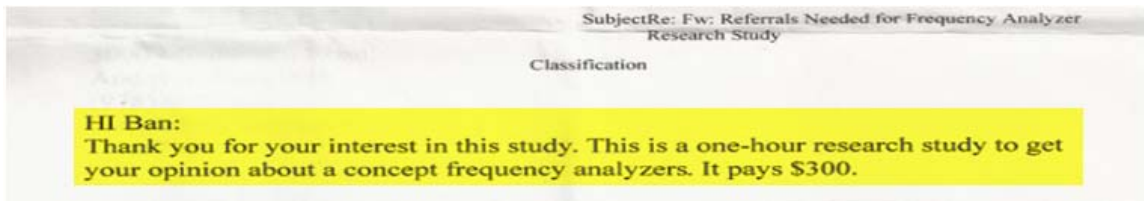
**This is your own business**; from the beginning, both you & Phuong have not want any members from the VPDPA organization to be involved in the 2009 National Convention committee or any decision making, especially towards the Treasury. I have asked you many times to allow Dr Judy Nghiem to hold the treasury for the 2009 Convention. You have denied it. I remember clearly, you told us at the meeting this convention has nothing to do with VPDPA. **It's clearly a cover up plan, and shows that you are taking advantage of the people from your organization and people from community to create a business for You & Phuong to benefit from.**

If you are holding my money hostage in exchange for my continued free services, you are mistaken. I give you three days from today, October 19, 2009, to reimburse me fully. By the end of the third day which will be 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 21, 2009, I will be forced to take legal action against you and the VPDPA/VAMA for larceny, extortion, and defamation, among other counts. VPDPA/VAMA and/or you will bear the Attorney's costs in the law suit. I believe it is time for me to assert my principles in dealing with you and VPDPA/VAMA. - Check or cash must be paid in advance to Child Medical Connection, Inc. (<http://www.misterjoe.org>) these kids are in need of help. Winter is coming. I'm sure these kids need help to pay for their rent, heat, food, travel, etc. and my hard work will support their needs.



- I can also negotiate with you or whomever you appoint to deal with me regarding the remaining work. If necessary I will present myself to the VPDPA/VAMA committee, CPA or your lawyer. I will explain all incomes and expenses of the convention.

On Sep 23, 2009. Next day, I went on different computers to return Dr. Tri request.

And here's what happened:

[You came to my house for convention meeting, using my computer to access your email https://mail.google.com/a/vamaboston.org and never logged out.](https://mail.google.com/a/vamaboston.org)

Gmail saves the last log in information on that computer until you sign out. In this case, you accessed your email on my computer and closed window, but never signed out. The next person then used the computer, and logged in using Gmail. Gmail remembered last person to log-in and directly logged in the same account without asking for neither the user name, nor the Password.

If you do not believe it, try it.

Remember this Phuong; every time you use someone's computer make sure you sign out before closing the windows.

If you access Gmail, this computer remembers the last person to log-in using Gmail, and sign-in the same account.

As a webmaster managing the domain, your administrator can reset your password, disable your account, but CAN NOT ACCESS your account unless you have given them your password or log-in his or her computer without log-out in this case you was using my computer to access your account email and never sign out.
